And for dinner he eats 500 million red ants.

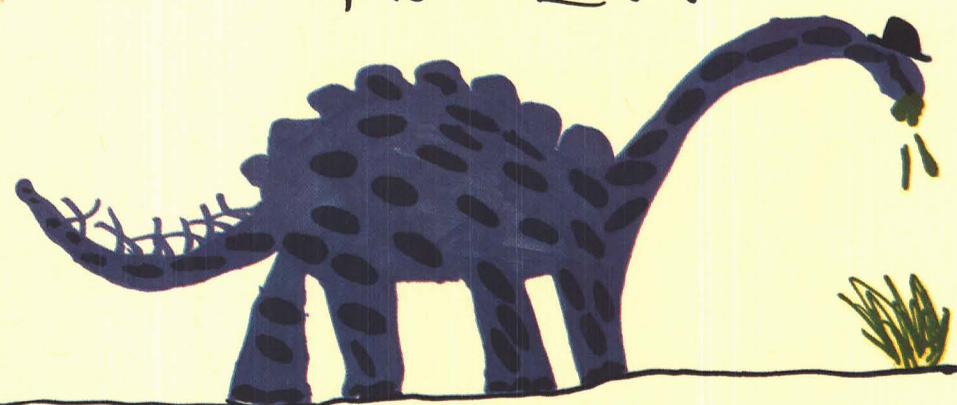

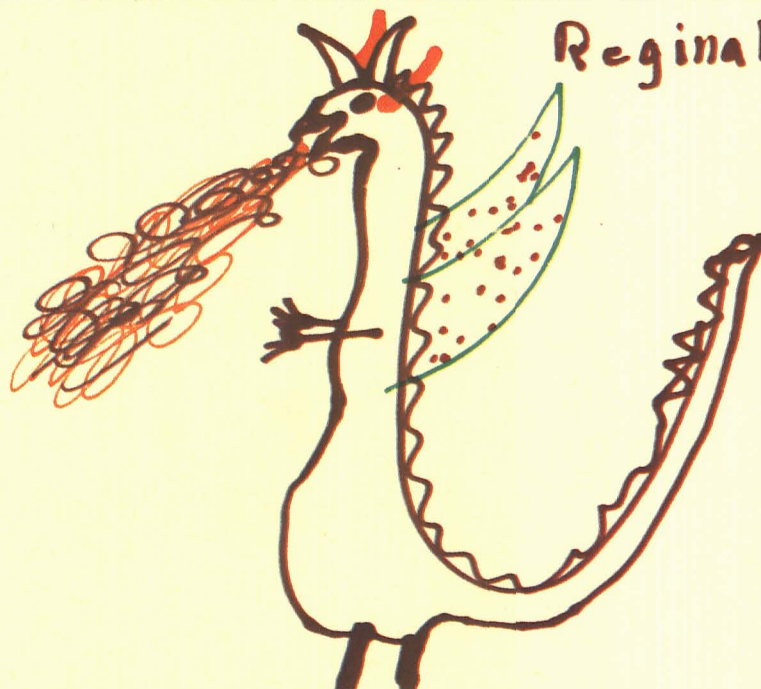

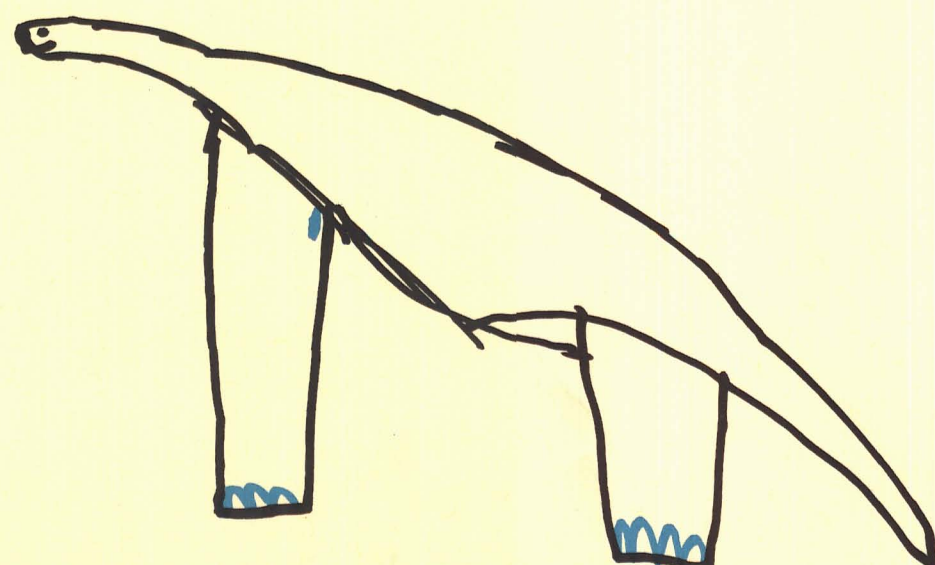

- CONTINUE GLUEING STRIPS AND FOLDING PAGES ALTERNATELY BACK AND FORTH LIKE AN ACCORDION TO MAKE ONE LONG FOLDED BOOK.
